Who we are: The RI Nurse Educator Council is a coalition of nurse educators dedicated to improving and promoting nursing education in Rhode Island.

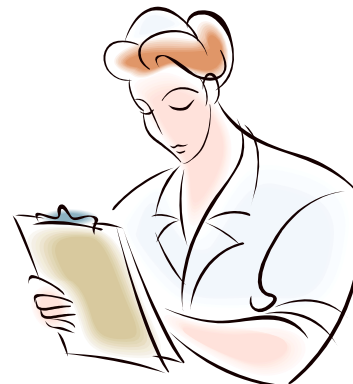
Nurse Educator Council
